Database Entry Assistance

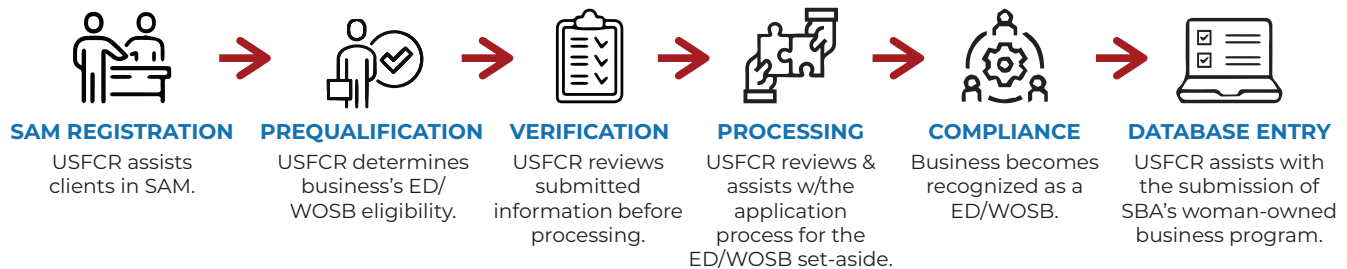
Businesses cannot get all of the benefits of the ED/WOSB set-aside if they aren't registered in the SBA's woman-owned program.
